

***NYSED: NEW REGISTRATION REGULATIONS***  
***CTLE: CONTINUING TEACHER AND LEADER EDUCATION***  
***JULY 1, 2016***

**Highlights**

- 3 main areas of the new law:
  - Registration: Beginning July 1, 2016, all permanently or professionally certified administrators, teachers and/or Level III teaching assistant certificate holders will be **required** to register **every 5 years** with NYSED through their TEACH account
    - Birth Month for the initial registration (penalty fee for late registration)
    - Renewal in the last year of each subsequent 5 year period (during birth month)
  - Individuals who hold a professional certificate must complete a minimum of 100 hours of professional development every 5 years
  - PD must be completed through a NYSED approved sponsor

**Who Does the New Law Affect?**
